

"State Officers **Dress Code**"

The following Dress Code was created and approved September 27, 1975 and revised August 1, 1991 by the Detachment Executive Committee.

The following shall be worn by **ALL** Detachment Officers at Detachment Conventions, Parades and any other such function, that you are representing the Sons of The American Legion.

YOU WILL ALWAYS WEAR YOUR DETACHMENT CAP

Dress Pants, Sport Coat or Suit	(Navy Blue Blazer Preferred)
Light or dark Colored Dress Pants	(Gray Pants Preferred)
Dress Shoes	(Black Preferred)
Tie	(SAL Tie Preferred)
Name Tag	

The display of items on the S.A.L. Detachment cap shall be restricted to a limited number of pins, in respect to the office of which you were elected. **(Limit 3 to 4 Pins)**

You will **NOT** wear **WILD** or **LOUD** colored clothes. Detachment Officers will be uniformly attired. You may dress casually for the Spring, Fall and Winter Detachment Executive Committee meetings, but your Detachment Cap Must be worn at all times. **(NO BLUE JEANS OR SHORTS)**

The above guidelines will be enforced. A \$1.00 fine will be levied for each violation to those officers not Complying. This dress code and fines are not intended to offend anyone; rather it is only common courtesy and respect of our organization and its members.
