You should also start a log or journal for the 2010 consolidated report forms. Each time you or your squadron does anything related to the report jot it down. Here is a simple checklist to follow:

- When did it happen
 - Date
 - Time
- Where did it take place
 - Town
 - Address
 - Location
- Who was there
 - Names of workers
 - Names of dignitaries
 - Approximate number of attendees
- What took place
 - Why did you have this event
 - What was the reaction of the audience
 - What was the outcome
 - How much time was put into the event

Now you can submit this information to the media, and they can help you build a story. You will have the necessary data for your consolidated report form, your historian can use the notes to make a history book and you will have a record for future reference.
