I have seen many great relationships between the Post and Squadron, some where the Sons report and leave to attend their own meetings and some where the representative stays for the entire Post Meetings (except during closed sessions).

The Sons should be are working on their programs and viewed as an asset to the Post. Earn the respect of the Legion and they will want you to attend the Post meetings.
